Prez Sez,

HAPPY NEW YEAR Beemers!!!!

Baby It's COLD outside, well cold for Michigan. It was -2 this morning and the washer fluid is frozen. Here we are starting a new year with lots of promise for a great riding season. We will have our planning meeting during our March monthly meeting. We have a few new ideas for this year's riding. We will keep with our traditional rides, we do need a new Color Tour ride destination for October. The Waldo Fried

Bologna Sandwich ride has shifted to more of a weekday retired group ride. We are continuing the Wednesday night dinners throughout the year. Once it gets warm and the Southern contingent migrate back up to the Great North, the retired "Old Farts" rides will undoubtedly start back up. So keep an eye on the Club Activities tab at the Website, mcbeemer.org; and on the Facebook page, as well as here in the Newsletters.

The next meeting will be at the dealership, BMW Motorcycles of Detroit on Rochester Rd South of Avon (23mile). Our monthly meeting is always the second Saturday of the month starting at 10:30 am. We have some important by-law business to complete from the December meeting. We had a couple proposals for the by-laws, in Articles 9 and 10.

It was proposed that a change to the by-laws as required by Article 9 should be done with more than a simple majority vote as stated in Article 5. It was recommended that a super majority of the members present should be required to enact a by-law change. The definition of a super majority was in question and if that would be a 2/3's or 3/4 majority. Article 5 states that the club will operate on a majority vote, meaning 51%. The discussion was that changing the by-laws should be a more important vote and thus require a larger margin. This will be discussed again at the January meeting at which time a vote will be taken. To date, all the votes that have taken place in the club that I can remember have been unanimous with only one or two outstanding or abstaining. Proposed language for Article 9 could be "Any amendment or proposal to change the By-Laws of the organization shall be submitted to the president, be published in the newsletter and be discussed at a regular meeting before a "super majority" vote "of the members in attendance" is called. By-Laws will be reviewed annually during the May meeting."

For Article 10, the dissolution of the club with the remaining funds to be sent to a charity be changed. Most of the discussion centered on whether the vote on which charity is selected should be a super majority or simple majority vote of the members in attendance or should it be of the full membership in the club. But there is really no mention whether there should be a vote to dissolve the club or not. I think the dissolution of the club should be at least a 2/3's or 3/4 majority of the Full membership that can be contacted by the officers and brought to a final meeting at which time the a super majority vote of members in attendance will determine the charity to send the remaining treasury funds. Proposed language for Article 10 could be "In the event of dissolution of the Motor City Beemers, a (2/3's or 3/4) super majority vote to dissolve the club will be called by the Officers. The officers will contact the full membership of the

club with a notice of intent to dissolve the club. The notice will be published in the newsletter giving a date of the final club meeting. Each club member will provide the officers with their vote at the time of contact, or if they plan to attend the final meeting, hold their vote until then. All funds remaining in the treasury will be donated to a charity selected by a (2/3's or 3/4) super majority vote of the membership in attendance at the final meeting."

Moving off the by-laws to other club business. John Saarinen sent me the MC Beemer's registered logo. It is not what I thought it was so I will have a printed copy of it and our old logo at the January meeting for us to look at and see what we as a club want to do with it. We need to finish this so that we can then get a format that a vendor can use to print up some shirts, hats, banners, or flags.

The Mid-Winter Banquet is rapidly approaching. If you have not signed up and wish to attend, please get your \$10 to Jim Mick so that we can get a final head count by 9 February. The Banquet is on 17 February at 6:00pm at Louis' Chop House, 50355 Gratiot Ave, Chesterfield Twp. That is South of 23 mile rd. on the West side of Gratiot. This has always been a well-attended event and a lot of fun. We will have door prizes and at least one 50/50 drawing. For the Banquet, we do a fun prize called a Bent Beemer. These awards are given for incidents that happen to our members over the last year. The incidents are generally minor in nature such as a dropped bike in a garage or parking lot. These are more of the damage to the bike type incidents, where a little light hearted ribbing is in order. In a lot of cases, the recipient was unaware they were getting one. Hopefully everyone saw the email on this from Betty Ward.

Annual Dues are due by 31 January for you to stay in good standing in the club and get the benefit of a reduced cost for club events like the banquet. Annual Dues are \$15 for a regular member, and \$10 for an associate member of a regular member.

So, I hope to see you all at the meeting on the 13th of January. To our Southerly contingent, it is only a few hours by plane, you will also get to breathe in some of this winter wonderful slightly cool air, what do you say, you game for that?

MOTOR CITY BEEMERS NAME TAGS


