 - If you have an iPhone or iPad, pre-install **Jitsi** from the App Store.
 - If you have an Android device, pre-install **Jitsi** from Google Play.
 - If you want to use a desktop browser, use <https://meet.jitsi.org>.
- Use **JanuaryMcbeemers** as the meeting name.

If you can't make the meeting or have problems connecting, please feel free to vote for officers via a message to the Facebook Group. If you don't use Facebook, you can send your votes and comments via email to mcbeemers@groups.io instead. Nick has arranged for this new email group to replace Yahoo Groups.

As a reminder:

- If you participated in the third annual Off The Beaten Path Poker Run, please send your Poker Run photos to Nick via email or Facebook. And, please send Nick any other photos from your riding season that you'd like him to share on the club's website.
- Dues for 2021 will remain the same as this year, \$15 for members and \$10 for associates. If you've paid \$5 for the canceled 2020 Picnic, Jim will credit you for it in 2021. The member price for the 2021 Picnic and Frankenmuth Dinner will remain the same as this year: \$5 each for members.

NEW MAIL LIST SERVICE!!

As indicated previously, Yahoo Groups has “gone away”. I've set us up with a new group e-mail system based on the service, “groups.io”, which on my little bit of investigation so far, actually looks a little nicer than Yahoo Groups, at least for us. As before, the primary use of it is via e-mail – you send an e-mail to “mcbeemers@groups.io”, and it ends up being sent to all the members of the group.

IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS, you should be getting an invite for the mcbeemers@groups.io group via e-mail. I always tell people not to click on links on unexpected e-mail, and that still holds. However, you are now advised to expect this e-mail from groups.io, and the welcome message will include our club website and other things you should recognize as relevant, not a random bit of spam or malware.

If you click on the link, you will be given some options about how you get e-mail from the group. For our group, the two most likely to be useful to you are “receive all messages” or “only receive special notices” from club officers. I doubt this group will generate enough e-mail to be worthy of the “digest” messages (grouping all of a day's e-mail into one message). IF you prefer, you can also just respond to invite e-mail and you will be put in the group, but you if you want to change any options, you will need to create a groups.io account.

PLEASE do sign up for this. This is a primary means of communication between club officers and members, and optionally, between club members.

I'm admittedly complete new to the “groups.io” service. I know it's used for a lot of other things, so if you are a user and have tips, please let the club know of other ways to use the basic (i.e., free) version of this service. One nice thing, for the basic e-mail, no new password or account is needed. Otherwise, I'll be seeing what other tricks we can make it do for us.
