

August meeting notes, based on minutes provided by Nick H., since I couldn't attend. (Thanks, Nick!):

- **2021 Picnic: Saturday, September 11, at Columbus County Park, in St. Clair County**, in lieu of our monthly meeting. The Park's entrance is on Bauman Road, 2 miles north of Gratiot. We have the venue starting at 10:00am, for set up, meal prep, swatting mosquitoes and socializing. Food serving will start around 11:30. The club will provide water, soft drinks, brisket, and pulled pork. Members are asked to bring a dish to pass, and mosquito repellent is advised.
- **Frankenmuth Chicken Dinner: Saturday, September 18, at Zehnder's of Frankenmuth**, and an optional follow-on ride to Port Austin. There will be a club ride to Frankenmuth on Saturday morning, from Ted's Coney Island, 67176 Gratiot Ave, Richmond, MI 48062. Ted's is located at the intersection of M-19 and north-bound Gratiot. The route will be back roads through the thumb. 8:00am breakfast, 9:30am kickstands up. This is my favorite annual club ride, and I'm really looking forward to it! *(For the optional follow-on ride to Port Austin: the Blue Spruce Motel is accepting reservations from us without a deposit at the same rate as last year - \$119. Call 989-738-8650 to reserve a room for arrival the 18th departing the 19th.)*
- **Where's Waldo:** Rhys discussed the annual baloney sandwich run. He wrote on Facebook just after the ride completed:

*“And another Fried Baloney Ride to Waldo, Ohio is in the books. Six of us met at 9:00 this morning at Exit 15, the BP station on south I-75. We be four Marines and two LEOs riding an assortment of motorcycles. There was a Harley Ultra, a Victory, a Honda 1800A, an RT, a Bagger and my Classic. Today was my longest one day ride on it, a little over 400 miles. It was a good day. Thanks to all the riders that joined me on this belt busting ride. Until next August!”*

- **Lunch ride:** I understand that Rhys led the group to the White Horse Inn for a nice lunch.

I hope to see you at the picnic, in Frankenmuth, and at the October meeting. Until next month, when you have the opportunity to ride, have fun and stay safe!!





You can still send payments for any club functions using Pay Pal to 'jim@ridingiswonderful.com'. If you have a Pay Pal account (rather than using a CC/DC) and call me a "friend", neither the club, nor you, pay a fee. But if you use Pay Pal and a CC/DC, the club does pay a fee.

A very good way to pay is to use your Bank/CU 'Bill Pay' option. Most banks/CUs charge no fee, so at least you save postage. Once you input any payee name and address into their Bill Pay system, subsequent payments only require you to input the amount (and date). Please indicate in the memo for what you are paying.
