Greetings MC Beemers! April has sprung, although the temperatures sure have not sprung up much. IT'S RIDING SEASON!!!! Picture Kermit the Frog running around waving his arms with his head up high and screaming YYYYYEEEEAAAHHHH!!!!

Now on with the information. The next meeting is Saturday, 14 April 2018, at 10:30 am at the dealership located on Rochester Road, south of Avon (23 mile). Remember to park out in the open parking area to the Northeast of the dealership showroom, but not in the fenced area. There are plenty of open parking spots. If it is nice enough to ride, I expect you can park your bike in front or on the side of the dealership

showroom building. Lunch after the meeting will be at Puzzler's Pub at 3498 E. Bristol Rd, in Burton Michigan. After lunch we will head over to Rocky's Great Outdoors, on the Southwest corner of East Bristol Rd. and Saginaw Rd. Rocky's has a good assortment of just about everything outdoors and a lot of motorcycle gear. Plus a good assortment of vintage bikes on display throughout the store. Good place to just walk around for a couple hours.

The day before our April meeting is the Friday the 13 Rally over to Port Dover, Ontario, Canada located on the North shore of Lake Erie along Highway 3. The town goes all out and gets several thousand motorcycles throughout. A number of our club members have made the trek over to the rally the past few years. This year there will be two Rallies, April and then again in July. I would expect the July Rally to be very crowded.

Our April meeting is also our Nomination Meeting for club officers. Josh Grosse has graciously volunteered to be the Nomination Chairperson for this year and has set up an email address just for this purpose. He has received a few nominations, but with the size club we have there should be many more. So, please forward your nominations to [mcbeemers.nominations@gmail.com](mailto:mcbeemers.nominations@gmail.com), you can also bring your nominations to the April meeting and provide them to Josh at that time. After the meeting, Josh will begin to compile the ballot for the election of our club officers for the next year. Please check with your nominee to see if they are willing to be nominated for the office you have selected. Also, you can nominate yourself for any of the offices as well. Josh has the roster of club members to ensure any nominees are also a member in good standing (Paid Dues) for this year. Another point to be made about the officers, is that the term is from May to May as was changed this year in the by-laws. The new officers will take over at the adjournment of the May meeting.

In March we had our planning meeting to set the dates for our various club events and rides as well as some of the rides that our members like to participate. Please check the Website, [mcbeemers.org](http://mcbeemers.org) for club events, as well as our Facebook page, and the newsletter for the next months upcoming rides. I am not going to try and post them all here this time as I generally try to keep this to one page (or Two). But we have some of our traditional rides and a couple rides that were tried last year and for this year starting 1 April and going through 1 November, we have a new ride series that Cathy and Josh came up with as a different form of a poker run, called "Off the Beaten Path 2018 Poker Run." You ride to several or all of ten destinations in the state that is divided into 5 regions, 2 destinations in each region, get a picture of you in

gear or your bike with the object, then turn those in for the Mid Winter Banquet and get a playing card for each location visited, then you make the best poker hand and the top 3 poker hands will get a prize. Cathy and Josh have a flier with the contest rules, see the website or Cathy for details. Betty is going to try the B5 ride again this year to ride up to Traverse City and watch a semi-pro baseball game then spend the night and ride home on a Sunday.

The Picnic is set for June 16th at Ft. Gratiot County Park to the North of Port Huron. The Frankenmuth Chicken Dinner Run is set for September 15, and if interested an overnight in Port Austin at the Blue Spruce Hotel, get your reservations in. The two BMW National Organizations, the Motorcycle Owners of America (MOA) Rally and the Riders Association are back to back weekends in July, the MOA is 12-15 July in Des Moines, Iowa; and the RA is 19-22 July in Wellsboro, PA.

Rides in May are the Mini Rally, over by Sturgis Mi, actually being held this year in Delton, MI. the first weekend in May. Mike Madley heads over to Morton's Spring Fling at Natural Bridge Virginia, generally the 3rd weekend in May. That is the same weekend as the European Riders Rally in Kentucky that many of our club members have attended over the years. Over Memorial day weekend, Cycle Moore Campground in Interlochen, MI has their Vets Free weekend.



## MOTOR CITY BEEMERS NAME TAGS


